ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS/CONTEST RULES

ELIGIBILITY

This contest is open to ALL children, currently enrolled in grades one (1) through six (6), except PREVIOUS NATIONAL WINNERS. Entry in contest must be through a RECOGNIZED SPONSOR.

RULES

- 1. All building projects must be completed at the location and time designated by Sponsor.
- 2. All building projects must be completed within the allotted time.
- 3. All building projects must be completed using approved materials only.
- 4. All building projects must be relevant to the construction industry. Projects which depict people or animals will not be allowed.
- 5. All building projects must be completed by entrant, with no outside assistance from parents, teachers, etc.
- 6. Every participant must submit the Official Registration/Entry Form, signed by a parent or Guardian.

PRIZES

- 1. Each of the winning fourteen (14) regional semi-finalists entries will be submitted for consideration in the National finals, becoming eligible for one of three National prizes.
- 2. There will be a First Place, Second Place and Third Place National prize award.
- 3. Other prizes may be awarded at the discretion of local Sponsors.

PRIZE AWARD

- 1. Regional semi-finalists will be announced by March 30th. All winners will be notified and prizes will be distributed by the local Sponsor.
- 2. National winners will be announced by April 30th. All winners will be notified and prizes will be distributed by the local Sponsor.
